LEGENDS Project Officially Launched to Connect Generations Through Digital Storytelling and Cultural Heritage

The LEGENDS project has officially launched, bringing together older adults and young people in an intergenerational initiative that combines digital literacy with local heritage and storytelling. The project aims to create meaningful connections between generations while helping older adults strengthen their digital skills and preserve cultural memory in their communities.

Through local photo outings, digital storytelling activities, and the creation of an online cultural map, participants will work together to document and share stories linked to local places and heritage. By encouraging collaboration between young people and seniors, LEGENDS seeks to reduce digital isolation among older adults, promote volunteerism, and support inclusive learning communities.

The project has several core objectives: (1) enhancing older adults' digital competences, (2) fostering intergenerational engagement, (3) strengthening the skills of adult educators, and (4) promoting sustainability and cultural preservation.

Among its expected outputs are a trainers' toolkit for digital literacy and photo outings, intergenerational workshops that will produce a shared cultural map, an online repository of stories and resources, and a local cultural map highlighting community heritage.

LEGENDS follows an intergenerational learning methodology based on mutual exchange and respect between generations. It also uses a participatory, active, and technology-integrated approach that connects learning to participants' everyday lives.
